

BIMAKS ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

PROGRAMMES

- **Diploma in Registered General Nursing**
- **Diploma in Registered Midwifery**

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

a) SSSCE Applicants

Passes (A-D) in six (6) subjects comprising three (3) core subjects – English Language, Mathematics and Integrated Science - plus three (3) elective subjects in General Science, General Arts, Home Economics or Agriculture Science with General Science electives. The total aggregate should be 24 or better.

b) WASSCE Applicants

Credit Passes (A1-C6) in six (6) subjects comprising three (3) core subjects - English Language, Mathematics and Integrated Science – plus three (3) elective subjects in General Science, General Arts, Home Economics or Agriculture Science with General Science electives.. The total aggregate should be 30 or better.

c) International Students.

International Students may be admitted on the basis of qualification from their home country, which should be referred to the National Accreditation Board for determination of equivalences and eligibility for admission. Evidence of proficiency in English for applicant from Non-English speaking countries should be provided.

➤ **DIPLOMA IN MEDICAL LABORATORY TECHNICIAN**

(Duration – It is a 2-Year non-tertiary Programme)

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

a) SSSCE Applicants

Passes (A-D) in six (6) subjects comprising three (3) core subjects – English Language, Mathematics and Integrated Science - plus three (3) elective subjects. The total aggregate should be 24 or better.

b) WASSCE Applicants

Credit Passes (A1-D7) in six (6) subjects comprising three (3) core subjects - English Language, Mathematics and Integrated Science – plus any three (3) elective subjects. The total aggregate should be 36 or better.

c) International Students.

International Students may be admitted on the basis of qualification from their home country, which should be referred to the National Accreditation Board for determination

➤ **DIPLOMA IN MEDICAL LABORATORY TECHNOLOGY**
(Duration – 3 Years)

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

a) SSSCE Applicants

Passes (A-D) in six (6) subjects comprising three (3) core subjects – English Language, Mathematics and Integrated Science - plus three (3) General Science elective subjects. The total aggregate should be 24 or better.

b) WASSCE Applicants

Credit Passes (A1-C6) in six (6) subjects comprising three (3) core subjects - English Language, Mathematics and Integrated Science – plus three (3) General Science elective subjects. The total aggregate should be 36 or better.

c) International Students.

International Students may be admitted on the basis of qualification from their home country, which should be referred to the National Accreditation Board for determination

- **DIPLOMA IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION**
- **DIPLOMA IN ACCOUNTING AND BANKING TECHNOLOGY**

(Duration – 2-Year non-tertiary Programme)

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

a) SSSCE Applicants

Credit Passes (A-D) in five (5) subjects including three (3) core subjects – English Language, Mathematics and Integrated Science or Social Studies - plus two (2) elective subjects.

b) WASSCE Applicants

Credit Passes (A-D7) in five (5) subjects including three (3) core subjects – English Language, Mathematics and Integrated Science or Social Studies - plus two (2) elective subjects.

c) Mature Applicants

The applicant must be at least 25 years old, and show proof of age with birth certificate or any legitimate documentary proof of date of birth which is at least 5 years old at the time of application. Mature students must pass mature students' Entrance Examination in Mathematics, English Language and an Aptitude Test. In lieu of entry examinations, the applicant should show proof of credit passes in English Language and Mathematics in WASSCE or any other nationally recognized standard High School level examinations (for qualifications from countries outside WAEC's aegis).

d) International Students.

International Students may be admitted on the basis of qualification from their home country, which would be referred to the National Accreditation Board for determination

➤ **BACHELOR OF BASIC EDUCATION**
(Duration – 4 Years for Regular Students and 4 Sandwich Years for Sandwich Students)

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

• **Entry Routes**

The Department has three entry routes.

- Entry by means of SSSCE/WASSCE - (Entry at Level 100)
- Entry by means of mature students examination (Entry at Level 100)
- Entry by means of tertiary level professional diplomas (entry at level 200) depending on assessment of the diploma and performance at interview.

- **The general admission requirements for the various entry routes are as follows:**

SSSCE

Candidates must have passes (A-D) in six (6) subjects comprising three core subjects, including English Language, Mathematics and Integrated Science or Social Studies plus three (3) relevant elective subjects.

WASSCE

Candidates must have passes (A-C6) in six (6) subjects comprising three core subjects, including English Language, Mathematics and Integrated Science or Social Studies plus three (3) relevant elective subjects.

Mature Students

- a. Applicants must be at least 25 years (at the time of commencement of academic year of admission)
- b. Must show a documentary proof of date of birth (possibly birth certificate issued not less than three years).
- c. Must hold Certificate(s) of Professional Training from a recognised institution
- d. Mature applicants must pass a mature students' examination.

Professional & Post-Diploma Certificates

Candidates must possess a Higher National Diploma or its equivalent in a relevant subject from a recognised institution. Diplomas of Colleges of Education are acceptable. Candidates must pass an interview (Transcripts must accompany application forms).

➤ **DIPLOMA IN BASIC EDUCATION**
(Duration – 2 Years for Regular Students and 2 Sandwich Years for Sandwich Students)

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

• **Entry Routes**

The Department has three entry routes.

- Entry by means of SSSCE/WASSCE - (Entry at Level 100)
- Entry by means of mature students examination (Entry at Level 100)
- Entry by means of professional certificates (entry at level 100) depending on assessment of the professional certificates and performance at interview.

The general admission requirements for the various entry routes are as follows:

SSSCE

Candidates must have passes (A-D) in five (5) subjects comprising three core subjects, including English Language, Mathematics and Integrated Science or Social Studies plus two (2) elective subjects.

WASSCE

Candidates must have passes (A-D7) in five (5) subjects comprising three core subjects, including English Language, Mathematics and Integrated Science or Social Studies plus two (2) elective subjects.

Mature Students

- e. Applicants must be at least 25 years (at the time of commencement of academic year of admission)
- f. Must show a documentary proof of date of birth (possibly birth certificate issued not less than three years).
- g. Must hold Certificate(s) of Professional Training from a recognised institution
- h. Mature applicants must pass a mature students' examination.

CERTIFICATE PROGRAMMES:

- CERTIFICATE IN MEDICAL RELATED SIGN LANGUAGE

- This programme is compulsory for all nursing and midwifery Students. The duration of this programme for our nursing and midwifery Students is 2 Semesters. Students are awarded Certificates. The ability of the Students to communicate with the deaf on medical services makes our students unique in the delivery of health services.
- This Programme is also designed for all medical students at various Institutions; aspiring medical Sign Language interpreters and all healthcare providers currently working in the various healthcare facilities in the country. The duration of this programme for other Students is 2 Semesters.

- **ENTRY REQUIREMENT:**

SSSCE

Candidates must have passes (A-E) in four (4) subjects.

WASSCE

Candidates must have passes (A-E8) in four (5) subjects.

➤ **CERTIFICATE IN GERONTOLOGY (FAMILY HEALTH CARE)**

Duration is 6 months.

- **ENTRY REQUIREMENT:**

SSSCE

Candidates must have passes (A-E) in four (4) subjects.

WASSCE

Candidates must have passes (A-E8) in four (5) subjects.
